JOB SUMMARY: Transport, repair and replace tires on agricultural equipment, automotive and fleet vehicles.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: To perform thorough tire, wheel and rim inspections and related repairs on tires on agricultural equipment. Provide excellent on-call customer service, responding to customer needs for repair and replacement of tires.

Specifically:

- Respond to service calls; travelling in specified agricultural region
- Move tires around yard and sort tires for diagnosis and repair purposes; load and unload tires
- Transport tires and equipment utilizing company vehicle and hoist; coordinate hauling of equipment as necessary
- Provide diagnosis and accurate repair estimates
- Repair tires; ensuring customer's needs are met and completed in a timely fashion
- Verify customer information as current on all work orders
- Collection of payment for work performed if necessary
- Perform additional duties as requested by management
- Maintain safe work standards
- Regular attendance is an essential function

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Possess valid drivers' license; ability to be insured as a driver for McFarlane Mfg. Co.
2. Knowledge of tire diagnosis, maintenance, replacement and repair.
3. Ability to push, lift, move tractor tires as needed, up to 100 lbs.
